form	printed document with blank spaces

journalism	writing for a newspaper or magazine
literature	published written work
quotation	what someone says word for word

second person	referring to the person being addresses; you
sonnet	poem with 14 lines
symbolism	using a symbol to represent an idea
table	systematic arrangement of data
tale	imaginative narrative of an event
term	word or expression that has a precise meaning
third person	told by an outside narrator
tone	attitude a writer takes towards an audience
viewpoint	point of view; way the story is told
voice	personality of writing
